Notice of Making of Special Extinguishment and Diversion Order

- 1. West Sussex County Council (Southwater) Public Path (No.1650) Part Special Extinguishment Order 2016**
- 2. West Sussex County Council (Southwater) Public Path (No.1642) Part Special Diversion Order 2016**

The above named Orders were made on 17<sup>th</sup> March 2016 under sections 118B and 119B of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the orders is to:

1. Extinguish part of public footpath 1650 (approximately 180 metres in length) commencing at a point east of Stedman's Cottages (GR 514421, 127923) and extending generally north to join with public bridleway 1642
2. Divert part of public bridleway 1642, to the south of Christ's Hospital School, commencing at its junction with public bridleway 3568, (GR 514359, 128261) and continuing south east, south and then generally east to GR 514503, 128079 and substitute that with a new length of bridleway 4 metres in width commencing at the eastern end of the length of path to be stopped up, GR 514503,128079 and continuing along the eastern and south edge of the school playing field to join with public bridleway 1650 at GR 514569, 127896.

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to Legal Services (ref:CC3/13022/AD) West Sussex County Council, County Hall, Chichester, West Sussex PO19 1RQ or [legal.services@westsussex.gov.uk](mailto:legal.services@westsussex.gov.uk) not later than 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2016. Please state the grounds on which they are made. Please note that any representations or objections received will be held on a file which is open to the public and while details will be omitted on request, they will become publicly available if and when the order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the West Sussex County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation, any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
