Special Extinguishment Order for Certain Highways which Cross Land Occupied for the Purposes of a School

West Sussex County Council (Southwater) Public Path (No.1650) Part Special Extinguishment Order 2016

This Order is made by the West Sussex County Council ("the council") under section 118B(4) of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the council that as respects the relevant highway described in article 1 below ("the highway")—

- (a) the council are the highway authority for the highway;
- (b) the highway crosses land occupied for the purposes of a school; and
- (c) it is expedient for the purposes of protecting the pupils or staff from—
 - (i) violence or the threat of violence,
 - (ii) harassment,
 - (iii) alarm or distress arising from unlawful activity, or
 - (iv) any other risk to their health or safety arising from such activity, that the highway should be stopped up.

The Police Authority (Sussex Police Authority) for the area in which the highway lies has been consulted as required by section 118B(6) of the 1980 Act.

The Horsham District Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2)(a) of the 1980 Act

BY THIS ORDER:

- The public right of way over the land situate at Southwater shown by a continuous bold line on the map contained in this Order and described in the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
- Notwithstanding anything in paragraph 1 of this Order, where immediately before the date on which a highway is stopped up in pursuance of this Order there is apparatus on, under or over that highway belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus they then had.


